Dear CISV Friends and Families,

The delegations for Atlanta's first Village (June 28-July 25, 2019) will be arriving soon! As some of you are likely starting to make plans for the summer, please consider serving as a host family for the 2019 Atlanta Village. It's a great way to experience a little bit of the world while staying in your own home.

There are two opportunities for hosting during the village:

The **first opportunity** for hosting will be **June 28-June 30** when the majority of the delegations arrive. Depending upon air times, we may actually have delegations coming in a few days earlier. Please let us know on your application, if you can offer accommodations as early as June 26. This opportunity requires hosting one of the twelve delegations, and they could be from anywhere in the world! You must be able to accommodate two to four children and pick them up from the airport upon arrival (we can provide additional transportation if you can't accommodate them all in your vehicle). There may also be an opportunity to host their leader, so let us know if that's an option for you.

The **second opportunity** for hosting will be **July 12-14**, during the Leader's Weekend. This is the time the leaders get a break while the children are divided into same-gender groups and have the opportunity to experience a typical American lifestyle. You'll host either 2 or 4 children of the same gender and they'll probably be from different countries. **We will be asking homestay families to do their host children's laundry during this stay. We'll also ask you to provide them with a shopping opportunity at a local mall. They'll be bringing their own money and want to take home some souvenirs from their visit to Atlanta, so a trip to a mall will be a fun excursion for them.**

In addition to having a strong understanding of the CISV philosophy, the ideal host family should also have plenty of time to spend with the delegates and have a genuine interest in learning about the delegates' culture and in sharing their own. Your responsibility is to treat the delegates as members of your own family while they stay with you and to provide a balance of busy and restful family-oriented activities for the delegates that require limited travel.

We will be providing Host Families with a list of the Excursions we will be taking as a Village group so Host Families will not inadvertently plan events or experiences for the kids that have already been planned for them during the Village program.
